Some of the town's attractions:

- 1 - Market Cross - a great meeting point. This has been here for 500 years at the centre of the town and the countryside's market business.
- 2 - Chichester Cathedral - England's only Cathedral tower roof visible from the sea, and a landmark to identify this town from miles around. A typical Gothic design, but what makes the Cathedral unusual is the separate bell tower.
West Street = DROP-OFF & MEETING POINT.
- 3 - Shopping area - very easy to walk and shop on the simple 4 streets. Although the town is old, there are many modern shops are housed in old buildings.
- 4 - Bishop's Palace Gardens - a glorious free garden where you get a good view of the Cathedral and can look over the ancient walls.
- 5 - Museum - this is free and has displays of local life through the ages.
- 6 - Priory Park and Guildhall - a wide park with a small museum in the Guildhall, which is actually within a church!
